A monthly face to face Prayer Meeting in someone's home. This could be rotated so say one month Bridestowe, another Hatherleigh, another Okehampton. So if anyone would like to offer their home for this in Bridestowe and Hatherleigh please let me know. I'm happy to host Okehampton.

A zoom Prayer Group could be set up. If there is anyone willing to do this please let me know.

Choose a time on a particular day to pray from your home, knowing others are joining you, for example 10am on a Friday.
